Christmas performances

We are almost into the festive season (it isn't Christmas until December!!!) and all the children are getting very excited to show their performances to their adults. Tickets can be collected from midday, Monday 5th December from the school office. Please remember to bring your ticket on the day.

Attendance

The national expectation for school attendance is 97%. Abingdon Primary School's attendance currently is 93.7% this is falling short of the target set by the Government. This continues to be a concern of the school. I know that this time of year brings out the seasonal colds and viruses, but please try to send your child in to school. Trust that if they are truly poorly we will contact you to collect them. There has been many a time where we have woken feeling under the weather, but once we have moved around a bit and gotten some fresh air, we have felt much better. This is often the case with children. Once here and engrossed with learning and friends they feel much better.

Attendance treat

On Wednesday 21st December we will be having our attendance treat for those children whose cumulative attendance is over 97%, and those children who have significantly improved their attendance since September. Further details will be given in next week's newsletter

Public Health Information

As I mentioned above, we are truly in the winter season, and with the cold weather, comes viruses and colds. We are aware of the media coverage of a rise in a number of viruses across the country. As a school, we have had no reported cases of Strep A, but we are attaching a letter from the local authority regarding different viruses that are prevalent this time of year, and what to look out for.

Cold Weather

The weather is getting much colder now. Please make sure your child comes to school with **a coat** and as the weather cools even more – hats and gloves. When they go out into the playground it is very cold, even when they are running around! Well-being Challenge: This week's challenge is pretty simple. Have a pyjama day and watch festive films on TV!!




School Lottery

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Covid-19 advice

- Children with mild symptoms of a respiratory infection include covid-19 but are otherwise well should continue to attend school. They should stay home if they have a high temperature and are unwell, and can return to school when they no longer have a high temperature/feel well enough.
- It is not recommended that children should have a covid-19 test unless directed to by a health professional, but if a child under 18 does test positive, they should stay off school for 3 days after the day they took the test. They can return to school after the 3 days if they are well enough.

The isolation period for COVID-19 is 6 days with a negative LFD test (24 hours apart on day 5 and day 6). See the link below for more information

School advice is still:

If your child is displaying any of these COVID related symptoms

- -a high temperature
- -a new, continuous cough
- -a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste

or

if your child receives a positive lateral flow test, they should remain at home until they are feeling well again.

Please inform school if anyone in your child's household tests positive for Covid-19.
