Arrangements for School Reopening – Monday 8th March

Drop off and Pick up will remain the same as before closure – this is a reminder of arrangements. **ONE WAY SYSTEM REMAINS IN THE PLAYGROUND** – this has been approved by Health and Safety so please help us by keeping to this system.

KS1

- All doors will be open at 8:40am and 3:05pm for sibling collection/drop off.

KS2 (Falcons, Kites, Owls, Kestrels, Ospreys)

- A member of staff will be there to collect children at the allocated time
- Home time: each class has their own zone in the playground. Once parent/carers arrive with their child(ren), the gates will open and parents/carers will pick up and go out via GA gate. If it is raining heavily, classes will line up in the hall 2+ m apart until all classes going at the same time are down.
- All classes will be down promptly.
- When at the lockers staff will supervise closely to ensure no close contact with other bubbles.

Siblings

As before; to drop off siblings- parents/carers will come at the drop off time that is **latest for their children**. Then the other child can either go up themselves as the class is already in (KS2) or be dropped off at the classroom (KS1/Rec)

Safety

Children/parents will **keep to the path in the car park** and not play in the car park area.
All adults on site to wear face masks.



Gates

- Mr Bosson will open the exit gates first (infant and GA) at 8:35am and then the Children's Centre car park gate at 8:40am. He will then close all the gates at 9:05am.
- All adults are asked to leave the site as soon as they have dropped off/collected their child(ren).
- Any appointments with staff members are to be made in advance.
- Mr Bosson will close all the gates after collection at 3:20pm.

Mrs Clark, Ms Flanders, Mr Cumberbatch, Miss Waters and SLT (when available) will be on the playgrounds if free. In the first few days Ms Flanders and Mr Cumberbatch will be on Abingdon Rd to help direct parents. Mrs Clark will be at different entry and exit points throughout the day.

Break and Lunch Times

Break times and lunch times are staggered again to ensure children remain in their bubbles. Lunches will be served in classrooms for most children, using take away containers. Some children will eat in the hall at staggered intervals due to numbers and spacing. All children will have plenty of time, as always, to eat their lunch and have time outside. We will be serving a selection of sandwiches, wraps or other hot food cooked fresh each day for children to choose from if they have a school lunch. We will maintain a one way system around school and regularly review our risk assessment to ensure practice and systems are as safe as possible.

Our Sports coaches will return to site to lead P.E. sessions during teachers' PPA time, obviously ensuring that bubbles do not mix but children still enjoy sports time with their peers.

After School Club (ASC) and breakfast Club(BC).

- ASC and BC will resume from Monday 8th March. It is bookable in advance (as it was previously). **Children will be unable to attend without booking.** Parents should use School Spider to book and pay.
- For collection: Parents/carers collecting will ring the bell on the gate on arrival (as previously) and their child(ren) will be brought out to them.
- If parents need to contact afterschool club – (during after school club hours) e.g. to tell them they will be late/someone else is picking up etc. they can call the school mobile on **07816 364 789.**
