#### Head teacher's greeting!

Welcome back and what a great week weather wise to come back to! It has been very warm on some afternoons in school, but as usual the Abingdon Family have carried on! Well done to all the children and staff this week – it is not easy being in school in the heat, but everyone has been brilliant.

We have some lovely news to share this week too. Over the holidays, Miss Broxton got married. She said the day was perfect and we are all so pleased for her. She is changing her name- so will be Mrs Walker from now on!

This week has been our annual Keeping Safe Week. We have run it for the last few years to ensure that we have the time to talk about important issues that could save lives or just keep them safe generally! We have talked about sun safety, emergency services, online safety, basic first aid and keeping safe in the home eg electrical items, medicines etc. The week started with year 5 and 6 completing first aid training with the Red Cross and it ended with a sharing session in our celebration time to show what we have learnt to the rest of the school.

## Some areas of development areas that you suggested:

Can you bring back dance or gymnastics on a Monday night we loved that!

I think Dojo could be used more to give updates on a class level to say what they are doing that week or month.

I think staff absence needs to be communicated better, knowing what teacher will be covering the class would be helpful.

Would be helpful if some of the old dates for paying for things on school spider could be deleted as takes a while to find current dates when paying for after school club.

I hope the school can release more content about what the students have learned.

We thank you for your kind words, it is very uplifting for all staff to hear the lovely comments you made. We will also do our very best to address the areas of development in the coming months and will keep you informed as we do. Thank you again for your feedback.

#### **Attendance**

The national expectation for school attendance is 97.5%. Abingdon Primary School's attendance currently is **94%** this is falling short of the target set by the Government. This continues to be a concern of the school. I know that this time of year brings out the seasonal colds, viruses and hay fever but please try to send your child in to school. Trust that if they are truly poorly we will contact you to collect them. There has been many a time where we have woken feeling under the weather, but once we have moved around a bit and gotten some fresh air, we have felt much better. This is often the case with children. Once here and engaged with learning and friends they feel much better.

This term, we are looking at our attendance award system. We will be continuing to do our weekly extra play for any class that has a collective attendance of over 97.5% for the week, and the prize wheel for the class with the highest weekly attendance; but for the end of term award, we will be putting the names of all children with a cumulative attendance of over 97.5% into a raffle. The parents of the child whose name is pulled out of the raffle will receive vouchers for a meal for two at a local eating establishment.

## Smartwatches – with games and photo facilities

We are seeing an increase in children wearing smart watches that either have the facility to take photos, play games or both on them. Can we please remind parents that these types of watches are not permitted in school.

#### **Collection of Children**

Children in Years 5 & 6 are allowed to walk home on their own if we have permission from parents. All other children need to be collected by a responsible adult. We cannot release children to any child who is younger than 16 years of age, if they are below Year 5. No child in Years Reception to Year 4 should be walking home alone, this is a safeguarding concern.

Also, when dropping your child off in the morning, you need to walk your child to the door that they go in through, so that you know that they have been securely handed over to a member of school staff. We do not take responsibility for children below Year 5 until they have been handed over by a parent. It is not secure to leave them at the gates and expect them to walk themselves to their classes. We do not know that they are on school premises and they may leave the premises, without us knowing that they were ever here! Please take those extra few steps to ensure you child has been handed over safely!

#### <u>PE Kits</u>

We are very proud of the children at Abingdon and they look so smart in their uniforms! The expectation to wear the uniform extends to the PE kits, and we are starting to see, some non-regulation sports clothing sneak into PE lessons. Just a gentle reminder that we would ask that children wear the following for PE:

- Black joggers/shorts
- White T Shirt
- School jumper no other hoodies or jumpers please
- Black trainers

If children do not come wearing the correct PE kit, they will be provided with a spare kit from our lost property.

#### **Healthy Snacks**

Can we please remind parents that children should be bringing healthy snacks into school for breaktimes. Recently, we have seen an increase in unhealthy snacks being brought into school such as Doritos, chocolate biscuits, etc.

#### Covid-19 advice

- Children with mild symptoms of a respiratory infection include covid-19 but are otherwise well should continue to attend school. They should stay home if they have a high temperature and are unwell, and can return to school when they no longer have a high temperature/feel well enough.
- It is not recommended that children should have a covid-19 test unless directed to by a health professional, but if a child under 18 does test positive, they should stay off school for 3 days after the day they took the test. They can return to school after the 3 days if they are well enough.

The isolation period for COVID-19 is 6 days with a negative LFD test (24 hours apart on day 5 and day 6). See the link below for more information
