Updated system from Monday 13th September for drop off

Please stick to your specific drop off time in the morning.

The entry gate is open from 8:35am until 9:00am.

Reception and KS1 drop off time is from 8:45am, and KS2 drop off time is from 8:50am

Reception and KS1 continue to enter school through their classroom door.

KS2 walk past the stairwell entrance used previously, and walk round by the hall to enter school THROUGH THE HALL as they did last year.

Reception and KS1 classroom doors open at 8:45am The Hall door for KS2 children open at 8:50am.

Please make sure you drop off your child(ren) at the eldest child's allocated time. Thank you.

Please do not enter school through the KS2 gate as this is an EXIT point. The one-way system around school is to prevent congestion around the pathways of the school building. Please adhere to this system as a health and safety measure.



Attendance recognition arrangements:

- ★ The class with the highest overall attendance each week will have the opportunity to 'spin the wheel'. The wheel has many options of fantastic activities children can enjoy, such as wear your slippers day, extra play time and many more!
- ★ Each class who achieves 97% or higher each week, or who show great improvement, will have an own clothes day the following week.
- **★** ALL children who have over 97% attendance for the year, or who show good improvement of attendance, will have an end of year treat. Attendance monitoring

includes broken weeks and lateness. You MUST contact school if your child is late or absent.

The class with the highest attendance this week is: Y3/4 Kites with a fantastic attendance of 99%! Their treat from spinning the wheel is extra play.

Other classes who achieve 97%+ are: Y6 Ospreys and Y5 Kestrels. They will all have an own clothes day next Friday 24th September.

Railway Line Safety

We have been contacted by network Rail with the message below, regarding the high number of incidents in our local area. I urge all of our community to continue to share the importance of never trespassing on railway lines. There are video links for KS2 children. Videos have been shown in classes this week so please continue to reinforce this at home as well.

Due to the very high level of trespassing on the tracks by young people in your local area, Network Rail in partnership with Learn Live are working to help raise awareness to students across the UK educating them about the dangers of the train tracks through interactive digital delivery.

We urgently need you to please share the relevant safety videos with your teachers to show in class or send the link to parents who can watch it at home.

The session is less than 15 minutes and explains why it is important to stay safe near the tracks. Over 12 million students, parents and teachers from across the UK have watched these videos which has led to a significant decrease in the number of trespasses in their area through watching the safety videos.






Times Table Rockstars Tournament

The current government advice is still:

If your child is displaying any of these COVID related symptoms

- -a high temperature
- -a new, continuous cough
- -a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste

or

if your child receives a positive lateral flow test/PCR test, <u>they should remain at home</u>. NHS track and trace will inform all close contacts and advise them to also take a PCR test.

If your child receives a positive lateral flow test, they should take a PCR test as soon as possible to confirm.

Please inform school if anyone in your child's household tests positive for Covid-19.
