#### **Attendance**

The national expectation for school attendance is 97%. Abingdon Primary School's attendance currently is 94.0% this is falling short of the target set by the Government, and is also down week on week. This continues to be a concern of the school. Please read the attached sheet to fully understand the importance of good attendance and the impact poor attendance has on your children. The information sheet explains the legal obligation parents have to ensure their children attend school; the impact that regular absence has on children's learning and future and how we can work together to improve the attendance of the children at Abingdon Primary School.

## **Collection of Children**

Children in Years 5 & 6 are allowed to walk home on their own if we have permission from parents. All other children need to be collected by a responsible adult. We cannot release children to any child who is younger than 16 years of age.

#### Covid-19 advice

- Children with mild symptoms of a respiratory infection include covid-19 but are otherwise well should continue to attend school. They should stay home if they have a high temperature and are unwell, and can return to school when they no longer have a high temperature/feel well enough.
- It is not recommended that children should have a covid-19 test unless directed to by a health professional, but if a child under 18 does test positive, they should stay off school for 3 days after the day they took the test. They can return to school after the 3 days if they are well enough.

The isolation period for COVID-19 is 6 days with a negative LFD test (24 hours apart on day 5 and day 6). See the link below for more information

#### School advice is still:

If your child is displaying any of these COVID related symptoms

- -a high temperature
- -a new, continuous cough
- -a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste

or

if your child receives a positive lateral flow test, they should remain at home until they are feeling well again.

Please inform school if anyone in your child's household tests positive for Covid-19.
